The Opportunity

The Department of Pediatrics, College of Medicine and Saskatoon Health Region is seeking applications for a full time community faculty position in Pediatric Respiratory Medicine. Currently, we have Dr. Adamko, MD, FRCPC and Ram Natarajan, MD providing consultative services for inpatient and outpatient care. This includes provision of a pulmonary function lab, flexible bronchoscopy service, and a sleep lab. The successful candidate will work in expanding a program for improving the respiratory care of Saskatchewan children.

Opening in 2019, the Jim Pattison Children's Hospital, located in Saskatoon, will provide the full spectrum of pediatric services. We will have a state of the art facility for pediatric respiratory care.

The Candidate

The successful candidate must be certified as a specialist with subspecialty training in Pediatric Respirology (Pulmonology) and be eligible for licensure in the province of Saskatchewan.

The Region
