## **Position description**

The Respiratory Division, within the Department of Medicine of McGill University, invites applications for a full-time position as a member of the Contract Academic Staff (Clinical), as a respirologist clinician scientist at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor.

This position is based at the McGill University Health Centre and its Research Institute, and involves a research and clinical focus on asthma.

The Department of Medicine is a leader in academic medicine; our educational and research missions support excellent and innovative clinical programs across our teaching hospitals. The McGill University Health Centre is one of McGill's major teaching hospitals affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine at Canada's internationally renowned McGill University, located in the vibrant and multicultural city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec.

## **Job Duties**

The candidate will devote at least 50% of their time to clinical, epidemiologic, and/or translational research in the area of asthma. The candidate will be expected to develop and maintain an independent, peer reviewed research program funded by external agencies such as the Canadian Institutes of Health Research and the Fonds de Recherche Québec—Santé. Start-up research funding will be available to the successful candidate. The balance of the candidate's time will be devoted to patient care in asthma and other areas of respirology, and to teaching trainees at all levels.

The candidate will conduct their research at the Research Institute of the McGill University Health Centre: specifically, the Respiratory Epidemiology and Clinical Research Unit (Centre for Outcomes Research and Evaluation) and potentially the Meakins-Christie Laboratories (Centre for Translational Biology). Their clinical work will involve inpatient and outpatient respirology duties at the Montreal Chest Institute/Royal Victoria Hospital (Glen) and the Montreal General Hospital sites of the McGill University Health Centre.

The candidate is also expected to be actively involved in all aspects of McGill's academic mission (teaching and supervision of clinical trainees, graduate students and involvement in academic and administrative committees) and will be expected to demonstrate a commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion in these activities.

The successful applicant will take up this position in July, 2020. However, the start date can be deferred to accommodate subspecialty examinations and research training where appropriate.

## Qualifications and Education requirements

Candidates must hold an MD degree and must be eligible for licensure in Quebec and for certification by the Collège des médecins du Québec as a respirologist. They must have completed residency training in internal medicine and respiratory medicine, with certification in respirology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada by January 2021. In addition, they must hold or be pursuing advanced research training (minimum two years with MSc degree in Epidemiology or the equivalent), and they must demonstrate suitable training and expertise in clinical asthma.

All candidates must be fluent in English with at least a working knowledge of French.
