### Responsibilities/Duties:

The Section of Pediatric Respirology, Department of Pediatrics, Alberta Children's Hospital, Alberta Health Services (Calgary Zone), and the Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary invite applications for a 0.80 FTE position, at the Clinical Lecturer level or higher. The position involves 70% time for clinical activity in our respiratory service dedicated to serving children with respiratory disorders, including asthma, children with tracheostomy and technology support, cystic fibrosis, sleep medicine, and general respiratory medicine. Expertise in the areas of cystic fibrosis, complex airway and home ventilation and/or sleep medicine are assets. The remaining 30% of time is dedicated to collaborative research and teaching activities.

The Section of Pediatric Respirology is based at the state-of-the-art Alberta Children's Hospital (ACH). Service population includes the Calgary Zone, southern Alberta, southwestern Saskatchewan, and southeastern British Columbia (for a total of approximately 2+ million).

The successful candidate would join our Section of 7 academic pediatric respirologists. We are a dynamic group with strong interest in research and teaching. Our asthma clinic serves 5,000 patients. Our general pulmonary clinic treats children with a wide variety of respiratory disorders/concerns. Our complex airway clinic supports 45 children with tracheostomy and also those requiring home technology for ventilation. Our cystic fibrosis clinic treats over 140 children, and also includes an active newborn screening clinic. Our sleep clinic follows approximately 250 children using CPAP or BIPAP, and we have full polysomnography services performing approximately 500 polysomnographic studies per year. We also have support of a full pulmonary function laboratory and run bronchoscopy services on site.

### Qualifications:

The candidate must hold Pediatrics certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

The candidate must have at least 2 years of Pediatric Respiriology subspecialty training with a Royal College accredited program.

The candidate must be eligible for Licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta.

Must read, write and speak English.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and Permanent Residents will be given priority.

### Compensation:

The successful candidate will become a participating member of the Alberta Academic Medicine and Health Services Program (AMHSP). Remuneration for this position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Specialist On Call: There is an hourly on-call stipend from AHS that is out of scope of the contract.

The Practitioner is responsible for purchasing health and insurance benefits.
