The Division of Respiratory Medicine within the Department of Pediatrics at the Université de Montréal is seeking a full-time clinician to join the current team of 8 pediatric respirologists. The academic rank will be determined according to the qualifications and experience of the applicant and according to the promotion criteria of the Department. The position is based at CHU Sainte-Justine. The position is available immediately and could also be available to fellows upon completion of specialty training under certain conditions.

The CHU Sainte-Justine is a world-renowned teaching hospital dedicated to the health of children and their mothers. It is the largest mother-child health center in Canada and one of four most important pediatric centers in North America. The CHU Sainte-Justine brings together over 500 doctors, dentists, and pharmacists working in nearly 50 specialties and subspecialties. The CHU Sainte-Justine is affiliated with the Université de Montréal and is located in a vibrant and multicultural city.

The Division of Respiratory Medicine provides consultation services in general pediatric respirology and within specialized thematic clinics (cystic fibrosis, sleep medicine, congenital pulmonary malformation, neuromuscular diseases, home ventilation program, etc.). It has a complete pulmonary function testing laboratory (including an infant PFT laboratory) and a sleep laboratory.

Job Description

As a clinician-teacher, the candidate will participate in the following clinical activities: consultation service (inpatient and outpatient), bronchoscopy, and pulmonary function testing. Members of the division will share evening and weekend on-call duties. The candidate is expected to actively contribute to the department's academic mission through teaching and supervision of clinical trainees and graduate students. Participation to research activities or administrative committees is also possible.

Qualifications

- MD degree.
- Hold or be eligible for licensure in Quebec through the Collège des médecins du Québec.
- Specialty training in Pediatric Respiratory Medicine, certified by the Collège des médecins du Québec or equivalent (completed or to be completed).
- Specialty training in Pediatric Respiratory Medicine, certified by the Royal College of Physician and Surgeon of Canada or equivalent (completed or to be completed).
- Additional clinical and/or research training in an area relevant to the practice of pediatric respiratory medicine following specialty training above (completed or to be completed).
- Working knowledge of French (or willingness to acquire the necessary linguistic skills to practice in the province of Quebec).

Supporting document required:

- Cover letter and curriculum vitae.
- The names and contact information of two referees.
- Copy of MD degree diploma and specialty certification (if available).
