

Pediatric Assembly Early-Career Outstanding Contributions Award

The CTS Pediatric Assembly Early-Career Outstanding Contributions Award was established in 2022 as an annual award that recognizes the contributions of an early-career individual practicing in the area of Pediatric Respiratory Medicine in Canada. The award recognizes significant contribution in the area of clinical care, education, advocacy, research and/or other scholarly activity. The award will be presented during the Pediatric Assembly Annual in conjunction with the Canadian Respiratory Conference. The awardee will receive a mounted certificate and may have the opportunity to make a 10–15-minute presentation to their colleagues at the Pediatric Assembly Annual meeting. There is no monetary award for this recognition.

Criteria:

- Candidate is a member of the Pediatric Assembly within the Canadian Thoracic Society
- Candidate must be within the first 7-10 years of completion of their training in the area of Pediatric Respiriology
- Candidate is able to demonstrate contribution to the advancement of the field of Pediatric Respiriology within Canada
- Candidate holds an MD and/or a PhD
- Previous awardees are not eligible for the same award
- Nominations will carry forward for three years, nominators will be asked to re-confirm their nomination if applicable

Nomination Process:

A call for nominations for this award will be issued annually. Active CTS/CRHP members may submit nominations, and members may not self-nominate. The nomination form must be accompanied by the proposed candidate's curriculum vitae and two letters of support. The selection of the recipient will be by consensus. In the event that a consensus cannot be reached, a confidential vote will be undertaken, and the successful candidate will be obtained by a majority of votes. The CTS Pediatric Assembly encourages nominations from all young professionals and is committed to upholding values of equity, diversity and inclusion across the organization.
